BUS TOUR OF THE HEARTLAND ON SATURDAY 3 TO 5

Redwater is situated 4 miles from Alberta's Industrial Heartland, a 582 Sq. Km area that comprises fuel, fertilizer, power and petro-chemical companies from around the globe. First created in 1998, the Alberta Industrial Heartland Association is currently made up of Sturgeon County, Lamont County, Strathcona County, City of Edmonton and City of Fort Saskatchewan as primary members, and Redwater, Bruderheim and Gibbons as Associate Members. With over 40 businesses within the Heartland itself, the investment capital is estimated to exceed \$45 Billion divided generally into the categories of Chemical, Petro Chemical, Oil and Gas production, inter-dependent on each other for value added production. Overall, the industries are responsible for 30,000 direct and indirect jobs, and are part of the world's biggest carbon capture initiative.

For anyone interested, an approximate 2 hour free bus trip will tour the area north of the North Saskatchewan River within the Industrial Heartland. Although tours of the actual plants will not be available, the tour will take in the **Evonik Canada** (Specialty Chemicals), **Pembina Pipeline Corporation**, (Energy Transportation), **Wolfe Midstream**, (Innovative Midstream Solutions), **North West Redwater Refinery**, (Diesel Fuel Refinery) and **Nutrien** (Ammonium Sulfate Fertilizer) sites. The on bus guide will outline salient facts about each company and try to and answer any questions. Bottled water will be provided on the bus, but rest stops are only available before and after the tour.
